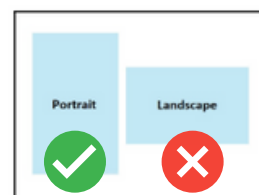


# SENIOR YEARBOOK PHOTO GUIDELINES

Dear parents and members of the class of 2026:

This is information regarding senior picture specifications for the 2026 yearbook. It is important that all seniors, regardless of the photographer they choose, follow the guidelines given below.



- All pictures will be cropped in a “portrait” orientation. If you submit a “landscape” photo, please be aware that photo will be cropped to fit the space. See image at right.
- All photos must be from the waist up. A headshot is preferred. Again, if the picture is not a headshot, it will be cropped to meet that requirement.
- No props (i.e. sports equipment, animals, instruments, etc.) may be included in the photo.
- No “selfies.”
- Backgrounds are allowed as long as they do not detract from the photo.

Please make sure to inform your photographer of these specifications. If there is a concern about how the photo will look when the yearbook is published, the adviser may ask the student for another photo. The yearbook staff also reserves the right to crop any photo in order to create the best photos possible in the yearbook.

Photos can be submitted digitally to [renee.mitchell@lakemills.k12.wi.us](mailto:renee.mitchell@lakemills.k12.wi.us). We will also accept photos in hard copy. The deadline for photo submissions is Tuesday, October 15, 2025.

Students may use their school picture from their ID or request to have a photo taken by the yearbook staff for inclusion in the 2026 yearbook.
