

# Facilities Referendum 2024

After 14 months of community feedback, the Lake Mills Area School District Board of Education voted unanimously to present residents with two questions to address our highest-priority facility needs.

#### Question #1

#### **District-wide Facility Improvements**

\$36.9M - NO TAX INCREASE\*

above the current tax rate for debt


- Address high-priority safety, security, site, and capital maintenance needs at all schools
- Reconfigure outdated learning spaces and special education areas at high school
- Renovate space for Science, Technology, Engineering & Math (STEM) programming, site safety, and health services at middle school
- Provide classroom space for early learning programming at the elementary school

#### Question #2

#### **Lower HS Gym Replacement/Expansion**

\$14.3M - Maximum \$2/YR TAX INCREASE\* for every \$100,000 of property value

 Replace small lower-level gym at the high school with a new, larger gym for school and community use

## **Maximum Referendum Tax Impact**


#### Due to current lower interest rates, the tax impact could be lower.








#### Question #2
