We have an update from Bia Food Company about a price increase for their first delivery in January, 2022.

Bia started preparing and delivering meals to Club 55 in September of 2020. They set a price of \$10 plus tax (\$10.55). Throughout 2021 they have held the price even though food and supply costs rose. They tried to make adjustments in other areas, but pre-COVID costs are not returning to their old level. Effective January 5, 2022, the price of the senior meal program will be \$12 per meal, tax included. This breaks down to a meal cost of \$11.37 plus \$.63 tax so the total cost per meal will be \$12.
