GENERAL INFORMATION

CANCELATION POLICY

A full refund will be issue if a program is canceled by the Lake Mills Recreation Department due to low enrollment or a facility usage conflict.

SELF- CANCELATION POLICY

Participants may request to drop out within 2 weeks of the program start date, including practices and games. Those who drop under two weeks of the start date may be charged additional fees which are listed below.

- All refunds distributed via check or credit card will incur a \$3.00 processing fee.
- All refunds distributed via Account Credit, will be placed in full on the participant's account. Account credits can be used for future registrations for any member of the account.

REFUND POLICY

In the event that a participant requests to drop out from a program or league at any time the following refund procedures will occur.

- Post registration deadline, pre program start-
 - If program materials are already purchased, and there is no one in line to fill the spot, a refund will be given, less the cost of the materials.
 - If the spot can be filled appropriately (or no materials were purchased yet), a full refund will be given.
- **During the program-** Individuals in non team activities who request to drop-out after the start but before the halfway mark, will forfeit 50% of their registration fee. Any adult team that chooses to drop out after the start of a program will forfeit 100% of their registration fee. <u>No Refund will be offered after the halfway point of any program.</u>
- Medical Withdraw- If a participant can no longer continue to participate due to a medical emergency, that participant will receive a prorated refund. The individual must provide a signed doctors letter in order to receive a refund.
- Relocation Refund- If a participant or the participants family moves out of any time before the start of a program will receive a refund minus the cost of supplies if ordered already. If the participant moves after the start of a program they will be issued a prorated refund.

WEATHER CANCELATION POLICY

- In the event that LMASD is closed due to inclement weather, all LMRD programs are also canceled.
- In the event of inclement weather, LMRD will try to make the cancelation prior to 4:00 pm. Program cancelations will be communicated via LMRD's website, email or Facebook.

RESIDENT VS NON-RESIDENT

Residents support the school district through tax-dollars, while nonresidents pay to participant through higher registration fees.

For program fee purposes, participant are categorized by

- **Residents (R):** those who reside within, open enroll, or work for the Lake Mills Area School District <u>including</u> those who attend the parochial schools inside LMASD district.
- Non-Residents (NR): those who do not reside within, open enroll, work for the Lake Mills Area School District OR attend the parochial schools inside LMASD district. A **\$10 non-resident fee** will be applied to all registrations for non-resident participants.

FEES/ LATE REGISTRATIONS

Fees are based off of the minimum amount of participants needed to successfully run a program. We do our very best to anticipate needs for now and the needs for the future of our programs so that we may set our prices accordingly. To ensure proper planning we may set deadlines for our programs. <u>ALL those who register after a set</u> <u>deadline</u> will have to pay an additional \$10 late fee and may also run the risk of not being able to participate if the program is full.

AGE/ GRADE REQUIREMENTS

Age and grade requirements are set to benefit all children and make instruction easier for the program leader.

- <u>Age restrictions</u> will be based on the first day of the program unless otherwise specified.
- <u>Grade restrictions</u> will be based on the current school year.. Summer will officially mark the new school year.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Youth scholarships are available for LMRD programs. These funds are available to those categorized as a Lake Mills Area School District "resident" (see specifics above). We encourage those in need to contact our office for more information.

PHOTO POLICY

Participants or their parents (if participant is under 18) permit the taking of photos, audio and videotapes during LMRD activities for publication and use as LMRD or LMASD deems necessary. If you do not want a picture or video taken of yourself, please inform the director or instructor prior to the start of the program.
