

Download Videos from the Internet Using RealPlayer

Use RealPlayer to download, share, and transfer internet videos.

The RealPlayer Downloader feature identifies embedded videos on websites. The Download This Video button appears near each available video. Use the button to quickly download and save the videos directly to the Library "Downloads & Recordings" for viewing anytime, even offline.

RealPlayer records the entire video regardless of when the download was started — two seconds into it, half-way through it, or even after the end has been reached. The download occurs in a separate window and does not need to be managed or monitored.

Multiple videos can be downloaded simultaneously. They will download in the background while other things can be done on the computer.

This feature works with the web browser even if RealPlayer is not currently running.



Download This Video button:

The Download This Video button appears just outside the top right edge of the video being viewed. By default, the button appears during the first seven (7) seconds after the page loads and, also, whenever the cursor is placed over the video display.

To Change Default Settings:

Open RealPlayer and click on the down arrow next to the RealPlayer logo in the upper left corner. Select Preferences, double click on Downloading & Recording and place a check mark in the box next to Enable Web Download & Recording for these installed browsers: Windows Internet Explorer 8.00. Also confirm or Browse for the location to save Files to: Click OK to exit Preferences.
