
Book: *A Walk to Remember* by Nicolas Sparks **Rating:** 5/5

This celebration lasts eight days. This year, Hanukkah starts on Sunday, November 28th, and ends on Monday, December 6th.

Some Great Holiday Recipes!

Traditional Latkes for Hanukkah!

Ingredients

2 1/2 to 3 pounds potatoes 2 onions, peeled 3 large eggs, lightly beaten 1 teaspoon kosher salt 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper 1/4 to 3/4 cup all-purpose flour 1 cup canola oil, for frying Applesauce, or sour cream, for garnish

<u>Steps</u>

- 1. Gather the ingredients.
- 2. Line a platter or plate with paper towels and set aside.
- 3. Peel the potatoes. Place them in a bowl and add enough cold water to cover them, so they won't turn brown. When ready to prepare the latkes, drain the potatoes.
- 4. Place potatoes and onions in a food processor fitted with a knife blade (also known as the s-blade). Pulse until smooth. Drain the mixture well.
- 5. Pour the potato mixture into a large bowl. Add the beaten eggs, salt, and pepper, and mix well.
- 6. Add enough flour so that the mixture holds together.
- 7. Pour the oil into a large, deep frying pan for shallow frying. Heat the oil over medium-high heat.
- 8. Carefully drop 1/4 cup of the potato mixture into the hot oil. Flatten the pancake slightly so the center will cook. Repeat with additional batter, taking care not to crowd the pan.
- 9. Fry for several minutes on each side until golden brown and cooked through.
- 10. Transfer to the paper towel-lined platter to drain, and continue frying the remaining latke batter in batches. Serve immediately with applesauce or sour cream if desired.



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Fun Christmas Cookies!

Ingredients 225g / 1 cup unsalted butter , *softened (or use salted, skip salt)* 1 cup (220g) white sugar 1 1/2 tsp vanilla extract 1 large egg 3 cups (450g) flour , *plain / all purpose* 3/4 tsp baking powder 3/4 tsp salt Icing for Sugar Cookies

<u>Steps</u>

1. Preheat oven to 180°C / 350°F (160°C fan). Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper.

2.. Beat butter and sugar in a large bowl until creamy (1 minute on speed 5)

3.Add egg and vanilla, beat until completely combined.

4. Add flour, baking powder, and salt.

5. Start mixing slowly, then beat until the flour is incorporated - it will be clumpy.

6. Dust work surface with flour, scrape dough out of bowl. Pat together then cut in half, then shape into 2 discs.

7. Roll out to 0.3cm / 1/8" (for thinner, crispier cookies) or 0.6cm / 1/4" (for thicker, softer cookies), sprinkling with flour under and over the dough so it doesn't stick.

8. Use cookie cutters to press out shapes and use a knife or spatula to transfer shapes to prepared baking sheets. (Keep dough that doesn't fit in the oven in the fridge).

9. Bake for 10 minutes, swapping trays halfway (Note 2), until the surface is pale golden and the edges are just beginning to turn light golden.

10. Allow cookies to cool completely on trays (they will finish cooking on the trays).


