Have your child sort the objects into different piles. Bruce Lansky</p>	<p>Use a laundry basket and have your child try to toss socks inside the basket. Count how many he makes.</p>
<p>Make up silly rhymes. Try using your child's name.</p>	<p>Measure cinnamon and sugar and mix. Sprinkle on buttered toast. Cut the toast into shapes.</p>	<p>Invite your child to build with you. Make a birdhouse, or simple shelf. Talk about tools and measurements you use.</p>	<p>Try doing a puzzle together with your child.
